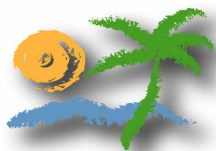

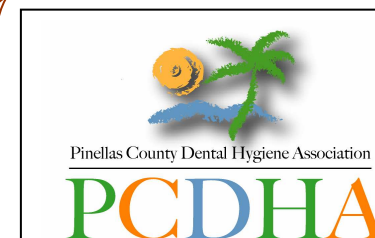

Guest Speakers

Lynn D. Terracciano-Mortillo, RDH (8-10) Evaluation, Assessment and Care of Dental Implants. Lynn is a graduate of the State University of NY at Farmingdale. She has been involved with the International Congress of Oral Implantologists (OCOI) for 15 years & is the Executive Director of their auxiliary section and on the ICOI Board of Directors. Lynn has lectured worldwide on implant education, had been a contribution author in several texts on implants and is an adjunct clinical instructor at Temple University, and a member of the implant preceptorship educational faculty at UTHSC in San Antonio as well as being a clinically practicing hygienist for two decades. This course is intended to provide attendees with background knowledge and clinical examples of implant care and maintenance. The visual and didactic components of this lecture will demonstrate modalities of hygiene care as well as options for oral hygiene instruction and implant maintenance and receive a comprehensive review of current clinical procedures related to implantology.

Tracey Jacobs, BSDH, RDH (10-12) What's Sex Got To Do With It? Understanding the Mythology of Gender Biology. Tracey is a graduate of the University of Alabama, School of Dentistry with over 16 years of clinical experience. She has served several leadership positions within ADHA including president and event planner since 1996. She currently practices in central Florida and is a part time professional educator for Philips Consumer Lifestyle, maker of Sonicare. During this course participants will explore the overall health and oral health concerns and how they affect females specifically- from autoimmune to pharmaceuticals and many other conditions, like heart disease. Research indicates that female gender differences should influence out treatment choices to achieve positive oral and systemic health results. Menopause and osteoporosis will also be discussed. Learn the specifics of treatment planning and delivery that is relevant in gender and sex-based biology.

Floyd Butz IV, BASDH, RDH (1-3) Prevention of Medical Errors. Floyd is a graduate of SPC and is currently working on his MPH degree at USF, has served in several leadership roles within PCDHA and is on COPA for the FDHA. He has been an adjunct dental hygiene instructor at SPC and is currently teaching dental assisting full time for Everest University. This course will explore types of medical errors, various factors that can increase errors, people at special risk for potential problems, patient safety, techniques for preventing problems and the law as it relates to Florida.
